

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

- G1. The premises shall be operated in accordance with the requirements of the Environment Protection Act 1973 and associated regulations. The conditions set down in this licence shall not be construed as an exemption from any of those requirements.
- G2. Except as provided in subsection (2) of Section 22 of the Act, the licensee shall not without the prior approval in writing of the Director of Environmental Control change any process used on the premises so as to cause:
- (a) an increase in the amount of materials used beyond that specified on page 1 of this licence;
  - (b) a change in type of materials used beyond that specified on page 1 of this licence;
  - (c) any alteration or change to any process or structure so as to cause an increase in the emission of any pollutant as specified under the Act; and
  - (d) an increase in quantity or rate of any discharge or emission from the scheduled premises.
- G3. All effluent sample results required to be obtained by this licence shall be subject to the following:
- (a) all samples shall be tested in a laboratory approved by the Director of Environmental Control or a Government laboratory or a N. A. T. A. registered laboratory;
  - (b) all samples shall have been obtained in accordance with the procedures specified in the codes of practice in ~~the Act;~~

**WATER POLLUTION CONDITIONS**

41. The following conditions apply to all liquid effluents discharged from the premises.

- (a) All liquid effluents associated with the process or contaminated in any way with effal or associated products shall discharge to the Municipality of Burnie Sewage Scheme and conform to such requirements as the Municipality of Burnie shall impose on those discharges.
- (b) Discharge of pollutants with the liquid effluent shall be prevented by all practicable means. Without limiting the generality of the term, practical means shall include sweeping, brooming either manually or by mechanical means, shovelling, impoundment or trapping in a tank or vessel for further adequate treatment.
- (c) The licensee shall ensure that thorough training and supervision of all employees and contractors occurs to prevent discharge of pollutant into the environment.
- (d) No material which could reasonably be dealt with in another way shall be hosed into liquid effluent drains which do not lead to a satisfactory treatment process.
- (e) All openings within the premises connecting to the polluted water discharge drains shall be effectively screened with openings not exceeding 15 mm. Screens may be made removable for clearance of blockages, but the arrangement must be such that this can be done only with difficulty, such as removal of a mortar seal, and not readily by ordinary staff.

52. The following liquid effluent sampling is to be conducted by the licensee:-

A composite sample, over at least 6 hours, shall be obtained of the premise's final discharge to the Municipality of Burnie Sewage Scheme once every 30 day period and tested for:-

5. Day Biochemical Oxygen Demand  
Non-Filterable Residue  
Oils and Grease

The results from these tests along with the flow, date and time of sampling as well as the total production for the preceding 30 days in tonnes, dressed weight shall be reported to the Director of Environmental Control every 60 days.

**SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT CONDITIONS**

S1. During storage or transport within or from the premises, all offal shall be contained as far as practicable by adequately sealed conveyors, hoppers or containers and shall be disposed of by processing, within eight hours of the time the offal is generated at the abattoir.

Alternatively, the offal may be disposed of by processing, or as specified in Condition S2, within sixteen hours of the time the offal is generated provided the temperature of the offal is not permitted to exceed five degrees celsius or if the pH of the offal is not permitted to exceed 5.

S2. Any offal that cannot be processed within the time periods specified in conditions S1, must be disposed of in a manner approved by the Director of Environmental Control. A contingency plan for this disposal shall be forwarded to the Director of Environmental Control by 31 December 1987.

S3. All offal and blood generated on the premises shall be disposed of at a scheduled and licenced premises under the Environment Protection Act 1973 with the permission of the licensee. No other disposal method is permitted.

S4. Paunch manure/solids and fat obtained from the saleyards/stockyards and holding pens shall be kept separate from other solid wastes and disposed of by land burial at a site scheduled and licenced under the Environment Protection Act 1973 and with the permission of the licensee. No other disposal method is permitted.

**NOISE CONTROL CONDITION**

- N1. Noise levels from operations on the premises shall not exceed an equivalent continuous A-weighted sound pressure level of 45dB(A) between the hours of 7.00pm and 7.00am and an equivalent continuous A-weighted sound pressure level of 55dB(A) at any other time when measured in the presence of ambient noise normally existent in the area at any residential premises in other ownership.

Where the combined level of the noise from operations on the premises and the normal ambient noise exceeds an equivalent continuous A-weighted sound pressure level of 45dB(A) or an equivalent continuous A-weighted sound pressure level of 55dB(A) as appropriate, this condition shall not be considered to be breached unless the noise emissions from the premises are subjectively audible.

The noise emissions from the premises shall be such that no tonal component is subjectively audible.

The time interval over which the equivalent noise level is to be determined shall be 60 minutes.

The method of noise level measurement shall be in accordance with clauses 6.1, 6.2, 6.5, 6.7, 7.2.1., 7.2.2., 7.2.3., 7.4 and 8 of AS1055.1-1984 "Acoustics - Description and Measurement of Environmental Noise: Part 1 - General Procedures".
